

Let's Talk About Inclusive Healthcare for the LGBTQIA+ Community

Healthcare providers will encounter LGBTQIA+ patients & colleagues.1

Creating an inclusive environment where LGBTQIA+ individuals feel safe & supported is essential for providing quality healthcare.¹

Inclusive & Affirming Language Instead of this... Say this... Legal name Birth name² If someone has legally changed their name, DO NOT ask about their deadname. Gender identity³ Sex/Gender Biological sex¹ Sex assigned at birth Do you have a partner(s) Are you married?4 or spouse? Use their first name unless Mr, Mrs, Ms² asked otherwise He, him, his, Use self-identified pronouns HELLO Default to "they, them, theirs" if she, hers, her² someone does not specify

Recommendations for Inclusive Forms & Policies⁵

Include questions about sexual orientation and gender identity on registration forms to communicate knowledge and inclusion of LGBTQIA+ individuals

Have write-ins for gender identity and pronouns so individuals can self-identify and not feel 'boxed in'

Cross-check information using birthdate, phone number, and/or address when one's identified name & gender do not match insurance/medical records, and ask clarifying questions respectfully

Use gender-neutral images if forms include images asking patients to identify areas of concern on their body

Use inclusive language on forms that respects different relationship types and status, living arrangements, and support systems
